

POLICY RECOMMENDATION

- Effective promotion of high quality of energy renovations through enforcing of needed training schemes
- Awareness raising by end consumers concerning the context between quality of execution, low operating costs and good living comfort of nZEBs

POLICY RECOMMENDATION

- Encourage architects and engineers to work with companies that employ highly skilled craftsmen
- Promotion of cross-craft cooperation of supply chain along with an increased focus on energy efficiency as a central point of a future-oriented, sustainable building construction

POLICY RECOMMENDATION

- Establishment of a system for proof and presentation of gained competences throughout Europe (e.g. based on the developed NEWCOM competence database)
- Enhancement of controls and evaluations on executed works (make the developer or contractor responsible for the performance of the building)
